1 Make ice cream in a bag. Take photos and sequence and retell the steps. (Google it)



2 Wash the bikes and wagon today. Talk about the parts and how they work.



3 Make kool-aid popcicles today. Describe each step and compare two flavors.



4 Choose gently used toys to donate for other children to enjoy. Talk about the joy of giving.

5 Watercolor Paint Day-Paint an ocean, beach or flowers. Talk all about it-expand vocabulary.

6 Go on a hike/walk and explore nature. What do you see? What do you hear?

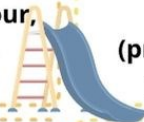


7 Make cookies for a community helper with homemade thank you cards.

8 Ice cream shop-talk about the flavors, toppings, sizes, and money to pay for it.

9 Sidewalk Chalk Day! Write the ABC's-Draw a picture for every letter.

10 Make lemonade today with real lemons. Is it sour, sweet, cold, refreshing?



11 Head to the park! Make predictions and use action verbs-(present, future, past tense).

12 Water the plants! Talk about the stem, roots, petals and leaves.




13 Make for pancakes for breakfast. Sequence and retell the steps. Draw the plate!



14 Look up at the clouds and identify shapes you see. Give clues what do they rhyme with?



15 Make a video for Dad telling him the Top 10 Things You Love About Him for Father's Day.

16  Happy Father's Day! Celebrate Dad all day long!

17 Go to the library to check out books about life under the sea/ocean animals!



18 Read about ocean animals and learn 3 fun facts about your favorite one! Draw a picture of it.



19 Sing Slippery Fish and act out each sea creature. Draw pictures of them.



20 Make an invitation for a playdate. Include: When? Where? Who?

21 Make a photo album of your neighborhood. Who and what will you include?



22 Go to a Farmer's Market and pick out a new vegetable to try at dinner.

23 Have a picnic at the park. Make sandwiches and pack, lemonade, and cookies to pack in the basket.



24 Call a grandparent to tell them about the Farmers Market and the picnic from the weekend.

25 Have a dance party today. Take turns choosing different types of music and make up dances.

26 Pack a pool bag! Help your child make a list of everything you need to bring. Enjoy the pool day!

27 Make a beach snack- vanilla pudding, crushed wafers- sand, and teddy grahams in gummy lifesavers.

28 Make frozen peanut butter and banana dog treats for the dogs walking by your house today!

29 Play charades with animal actions. Guess what animal I am.

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30 Make a basket of vocal play books to practice sound play and/or singing on each page.



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2 Have a picnic today in the yard and listen for sounds of nature. Point them out and label them.

3 Take a deep breath today! Name 3 things that your child does that make you smile!

4 Add a song to 3 daily routines today. Twinkle Star at bedtime.

5 Expand bedtime routine. Use a stuffed animal to for your child to brush teeth and tuck into bed.

6 Spend time today being face to face with your child talking and imitating the sounds he makes

7 Have fun with Ready, set...go in the stroller today. Pause and let your child fill in the "go" with his voice!

8 Make a microphone with the paper towel roll- play vocal imitation games with fun sounds.

9 Give an auditory cue/word to 3 daily routines this week! What sounds will you add to meal time?

10 Play Hide and Seek- one parent will hide and call child's name. Let your child localize and find Mom!

11 Bath time: Add vocal play toys and peekaboo with the towel. Rub lotion using soothing sounds.

12 Make a bag of board books to keep in the car. Encourage singing and vocal play on the go!

13 Sing Row Row Boat today. Rock or swing your child gently. Pause and wait for a request for more.

14 Getting Dressed: Highlight body parts with tickle games and hide and seek!

15 Make a photo album on phone with all pics of your child and Dad. Play it on the TV tomorrow.

16 Happy Father's Day! Celebrate Dad all day and practice vocal play with /dadadada/.



17 Let's blow bubbles! Sing songs pop the bubbles and encourage requests for more.



18 FaceTime Grandma today and let her read a book or sing a song to your child.

19 Dance party! Have fun playing Freeze when the music stops!

20 Fun with clothes- put them "on" and pull them "off!" Focus on hats, shoes and socks!

21 Log in to Hearing First Website to explore parent workshops and podcasts.

22 Pair objects to another of child's favorite books and bring it to life.

23 Treat yourself to a bubble bath, a hike, or yoga class and celebrate being a great parent!



24 Dress your child in clothes that are fun to talk about- a shirt with a dog, a dino, a duck or a shark!

25 Use your child's books to sing songs. Look for pictures of a star, a boat, or a bus!

26 Look through animal books today. Make sounds and sing Old MacDonald.



27 Water the plants with your child. Talk about each step and highlight "pour" and "water".



28 Out for a walk: Point out all of the animals on your walk. Birds, dogs, rabbits, squirrels etc.

29 Enjoy mirror play today. Make funny faces with imitation. Play peekaboo and label body parts.
